The sleek, new styling of the Corsair DASH 750 MKII's deck is what you will first notice. It borrows the same lines as the very popular Sprint 750 MKII. Cleverly, this also creates additional headroom in the forward V berth.

Inside the cabin, you will quickly notice a number of significant changes that will leave you thinking, "What a good idea..."

The finer finish has been achieved without compromising the exhilarating performance of the original DASH.



Key new features include:

- Sexy, modern styling for the deck (same as Sprint 750MKII)
- Additional headroom and space in the forward V berth created by the higher deck
- Significantly brighter saloon with carpet being replaced by a clean, white, liner
- Vastly improved sliding pop top with gas struts
- Trimming for windows
- Extended and strengthened seat backs for a neater finish
- Timber trimming added above seat backs to add warmth to the white lining
- Handy shelf installed just inside saloon giving sailors in cockpit easy access to phone, wallet, keys and sunscreen
- Improved galley option including additional storage

The Dash 750 MKII remains incredibly trailerable and ideal for camp-style cruising - or day sailing at up to 20 knots. It is tough, lightweight, sporty, exceptionally fast, responsive, safe. Developed from the well-proven Corsair 24 MKII and DASH 750MKI, this new model incorporates the same innovative folding system and accommodation features of the previous model. It has a modern rotating wing section mast, retractable alloy bowsprit, modern alloy dagger board, dagger rudder, plumb bow and the larger volume floats.



The base boat includes the following features:

- Large roomy cabin with standing headroom under sliding pop top with gas struts for easy operation
- Companionway hatch
- Interior carpet liner in forward V berth and cushions
- Removable dinner table which converts to a main cabin bunk extension

- Rotating aluminum wing mast with synthetic shrouds and bobstay, main, jib, screecher and spinnaker halyards. Four halyard clutches; stainless steel forestay; roller boom, 5:1 cunningham and 6:1 internal outhaul tackle; Hex-a-cat™ 6:1 mainsheet system; traveler with 2:1 control tackle; jib sheet leads & tracks, screecher sheet tracks



- Foredeck and float hatches
- Two Lewmar self tailing 16 primary winches
- Spinnaker hardware, including retractable aluminum bowsprit, two Lewmar non self tailing coaming winches, fairlead blocks, halyard, halyard clutch, tackline clutch and cam cleats plus deck organizer for halyards
- Electrical Package with 8 circuit switch panel, bow & stern light, interior light, lighter socket and battery switch (does not include battery)
- All models have a molded-in safety compartment for safety equipment and other storage compartments inside and out
- One timber tiller and timber table / bed
- Sports 2 rung boarding ladder with transom mounting
- Anchor well with hatch and lifting eyes
- Retractable dagger board & dagger type rudder
- Grey wing and bow nets with hiking straps & bow pulpit
- Tool kit with spare hardware items
- Sailing Manual
